Ablutions/Laundries

Please show respect to your fellow guests and leave tidy. Swimmers are requested to use external showers to wash down sand before entering abluion blocks.

Alcohol

Under S122 of the Liqor Control Act 1998, it is an offence for anyone under the age of 18 to consume alcohol within the park. Please be courteous to others and ensure alcohol is responsibly consumed.

Animals

Pets are not permitted in the park.

Barbecues

Barbecue fires are not permitted after 10.30pm. Due to fire regulations, no camp fires are permitted at any time.

Check-In

Check-in 2.00pm.
 Payment in full is to be made upon arrival.

Check-Out

Check-out 10.00am
 Requests for late departure may be made with management.

We request that all units are swept with dishes cleaned and wiped prior to your departure

Evacuation

In the event of an emergency requiring evacuation, management will advise and request/show how to proceed to the community refuge point in the large grassed playground area opposite the park signposted "R".

Eviction

Management reserves the right to evict anyone who makes or creates a problem in the park. No refund applies to any person/group evicted. Should you be disturbed by others please do not hesitate to advise management.

Fish Cleaning

Fish cleaning is not permitted in the park.

Keys/Remote Controls

Please return keys and any remote control to reception upon departure.

Noise

Radios/music equipment is to be kept at **low volume at all times (day & night) and off by 10.30pm**. Everyone has a right to enjoy a pleasant holiday and all noise and activity is to be kept to a minimum after 10.30pm.

No Smoking Policy

Smoking indoors in all areas is prohibited. Smoking is permitted on verandahs and around the park, however we request all butts be extinguished and disposed of in bins.

Parking

Strictly one vehicle only per site/unit is permitted. Second cars must park in visitors parking area or outside park at all times. Parking of boats, trailers, etc, can be discussed with management.

Playground

Only children are permitted in the playground and must be supervised at all times. Please respect other guests by ensuring noise is kept to a minimum and children's behaviour is acceptable. Use of the playground is at your own risk.

Reception/Shop Hours

8.00am - 7.00pm (peak periods/school holidays)
 8.30am - 6.00pm (other periods).

Recreational Activities

Ball games, bikes, roller skates, scooters and skateboards etc. are not permitted to be used in the park. Guests, children and visitors participating in recreational activities do so at their own risk.

Refunds

No refunds apply after commencement of stay.

Security

We recommend you safely store surfboards, wetsuits and other personal items at all times.

Speed Limit

Strictly walking pace (8 kph) for safety reasons.

Swimming

Beaches, water courses and surf in this area can be dangerous and we urge everyone to take extreme care. Lifeguards patrol Yallingup Beach during the January school holidays. Please follow their instructions.

Visitors

No visitors are permitted in the park after 10.30pm. Visitors vehicles must be parked either in visitors parking area or outside the park.
